# Subject: (i) The Southwest Monsoon has covered the entire country today, the 2<sup>nd</sup> July.

(ii) Heavy to very heavy rainfall likely over parts of south Peninsular India during next 5 days.

## Weather observed during past 24 hours ending at 0830 hours IST of today (Annexure I):

### Advance of Southwest Monsoon (Annexure II)

✤ The Southwest Monsoon has further advanced into remaining parts of Rajasthan, Haryana and Punjab today, the 2nd July 2023. Thus, it has covered the entire country today, the 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2023, against the normal date of 08th July (6 days before the normal date of covering the entire India).

## Significant Weather features, Forecast and Warning during next 5 days: (Annexure III)

- The Monsoon trough at mean sea level is south of its normal position.
- ✤ A cyclonic circulation lies over central parts of Uttar Pradesh in lower levels.
- ✤ The off-shore trough at mean sea level runs from south Maharashtra coast to Kerala coast.
- ✤ A cyclonic circulation lies over central parts of south Bay of Bengal in middle levels and another cyclonic circulation over north Andaman Sea in lower levels.

## Weather Forecast and Warning:

**South India:** Light/moderate scattered to widespread rainfall very likely to continue over the region during next 5 days. **Isolated heavy to heavy rainfall** also likely over South Interior Karnataka, Coastal Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal, Kerala & Mahe during next 5 days; over Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam during 03<sup>rd</sup> to 05<sup>th</sup> July with **extremely heavy falls over Coastal & South Interior Karnataka on 04<sup>th</sup> and over Kerala & Mahe on 04<sup>th</sup> & 05<sup>th</sup> July. Isolated <b>very heavy rainfall** also likely over Telangana on 04<sup>th</sup> & 05<sup>th</sup>; over Rayalaseema 03<sup>rd</sup> to 05<sup>th</sup>; over North Interior Karnataka 04<sup>th</sup> & 06<sup>th</sup> and over Lakshadweep on 04<sup>th</sup> July.

West India: Light/moderate fairly widespread to widespread rainfall with isolated Heavy to very Heavy rainfall is very likely over Konkan & Goa and Ghat areas of Madhya Maharashtra during next 5 days and Gujarat State on  $02^{nd}$  &  $06^{th}$  July.

**East & adjoining Northeast India:** Fairly widespread to widespread light/moderate rainfall with isolated **Heavy to Very Heavy falls** very likely over Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Assam & Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura during next 5 days and over Bihar 02<sup>nd</sup> & 03<sup>rd</sup> with **extremely heavy falls over Assam & Meghalaya, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim on 02<sup>nd</sup>** & 03<sup>rd</sup> **July.** Isolated **heavy rainfall** also likely over Gangetic West Bengal on 02<sup>nd</sup> & 03<sup>rd</sup>; over Jharkhand on 03<sup>rd</sup> & 04<sup>th</sup> and over Odisha during 03<sup>rd</sup>- 06<sup>th</sup> July.


No significant weather likely over rest parts of the country.




- Heavy Rainfall observed: Heavy to Very heavy with Extremely heavy rainfall at isolated places over Sub-Himalaya West Bengal & Sikkim, Assam & Meghalaya, Gujarat Region; Heavy to Very heavy rainfall at isolated places over Jharkhand, Uttarakhand, Konkan & Goa, Saurashtra & Kutch and Heavy rainfall at isolated places over Uttar Pradesh, West Madhya Pradesh, East Rajasthan, Madhya Maharashtra, East Rajasthan, Arunachal Pradesh, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura and Odisha.

### Agromet advisories for rainfall, thunderstorms likely over various parts of the country:

- Drain out excess water from crop fields to avoid water stagnation in Uttarakhand, East Uttar Pradesh, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, West Bengal, Sikkim, Bihar, West Madhya Pradesh, Konkan & Goa, Madhya Maharashtra (Ghat regions), Gujarat, Tamil Nadu, Kerala, Coastal Karnataka, South Interior Karnataka and North Eastern States.
- > Postpone nursery sowing of *kharif* rice in Sub-Himalayan West Bengal and *Sali* rice in Meghalaya.
- Provide staking to vegetables.

**Impact & Action Suggested due to extremely heavy/very heavy rainfall** over Sub-Himalaya West Bengal & Sikkim, Coastal Karnataka & Kerala & Mahe during 02<sup>nd</sup> to 06<sup>th</sup>; over Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal during 02<sup>nd</sup> to 05<sup>th</sup>; over South Interior Karnataka during 03<sup>rd</sup> to 06<sup>th</sup>; over Assam & Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh, Bihar on 02<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup>; over Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam on 04<sup>th</sup> July

## **A. Impact Expected**

 $\cdot$  Localized Flooding of roads, water logging in low lying areas and closure of underpasses mainly in urban areas of the above region.

• Occasional reduction in visibility due to heavy rainfall.

• Disruption of traffic in major cities due to water logging in roads leading to increased travel time.

- Minor damage to kutcha roads.
- Possibilities of damage to vulnerable structure.
- · Localized Landslides/Mudslides
- Damage to horticulture and standing crops in some areas due to inundation.

• It may lead to riverine flooding in some river catchments (for riverine flooding please visit Web page of CWC).

## **B.** Action Suggested

- Check for traffic congestion on your route before leaving for your destination.
- Follow any traffic advisories that are issued in this regard.
- Avoid going to areas that face the water logging problems often.
- Avoid staying in vulnerable structure.
