Petitioner complains that, despite a sum of Rs. 4,00,000/- being allotted in favour of the petitioner under the Victim Compensation Scheme, 2019, the petitioner is yet to receive the same.

State and the State Legal Services Authority (SLSA) are represented.

Learned advocate for SLSA submits that, the only fund available to them is a sum of Rs.5,000/-. He draws the attention of the Court to the letter dated June 17, 2021 by which, SLSA requested the State Government to put the authority into funds. The authority is yet to receive any fund from the State Government.
