Sub:- Consolidated Revised Guidelines on the measures to be talen for containment of COVID-19 in Brihanmumbai Mahanagarpalika limits.

(A) dated 15th April 2020

- Directions issued by Government of Maharashtra Revenue and Forest, Disaster Management, Relief and Rehabilitation Department, Dated 17th April 2020
- Vide reference No. 4 above, Chairperson, State Executive Committee under Disaster Management Act and Chief Secretary, Government of Maharashtra had issued an order on 15th April 2020 to extend the lockdown measures up to 3rd May 2020 to contain the spread of COVID-19.
- Vide reference No. 5 above, Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA), Government of India
 vide its order dated 15th April 2020 has stipulated consolidated guidelines for
 containment of COVID-19 epidemic in the country.
- 3. Vide reference No. 6 above, Chairperson, State Executive Committee under Disaster Management Act and Chief Secretary, Government of Maharashtra has issued detailed directions and order under No. DMU/2020/CR. 92/DisM-1, dated 17th April 2020. The directions are exhaustive and detailed covering various aspects of containment of spread of COVID-19 in the State. Apart from many directions applicable to entire State of Maharashtra, there are some exclusive directions for Mumbai. All the directions shall be observed and implemented scrupulously. Some specific directions exclusively for Mumbai are enumerated below.
 - a) To mitigate hardship to public, select additional activities will be allowed, which will come into effect from 20th April 2020. In Mumbai these additional activities will be operationalized by Brihanmumbai Mahanagarpalika (MCGM), based on strict compliance to the existing guidelines on lockdown measures. Before operating these relaxations,

- MCGM has to ensure that all preparatory arrangements with regard to social distancing in offices, workplaces, factories and establishments, as also other sectoral requirements are in place.
- b) It shall be distinctly noted that the consolidated revised guidelines referred to at Sr. No. 5 and 6 above WILL NOT APPLY in containment zones as demarcated by MCGM. If any new area is included in the category of a containment zone, the activities allowed in that area till the time of its categorization as a containment zone, will be suspended, except for those activities as are specially permitted under the guidelines of Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW), Government of India referred to at Sr. No. 5 above and those of Government of Maharashtra Under No. DMU/2020/CR. 92/DisM-1, dated 17th April 2020, referred to above at reference No. 6 above. The list of containment zones are made available on http://stopcoronavirus.mcgm.gov.in/insights-on-map and shall be updated regularly.
- c) Government of Maharashtra has made it further clear in directions dated 17th April 2020 at paragraph 3 (ii) that in Hotspots and Containment Zones the activities allowed under the guidelines of Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW), Government of India referred to at Sr. No.5 above and those of Government of Maharashtra Under No. DMU/2020/CR. 92/DisM-1, dated 17th April 2020 referred to above at Sr. No. 6, will not be permitted.
- d) There shall be strict perimeter control in the area of the containment zone to ensure that there is no unchecked inward / outward movement of population from these zones except for maintaining essential services (including medical emergencies and law and order duties) and Government business continuity.
- e) As per directions at paragraph No. 12 (iii) and at 17 (ii) of the directions dated 17th April 2020, referred to at Sr. No. 6 above, arrangement shall be made in each ward office to issue passes for movement of staff and contractual labour for operation of railways, airport / air carriers, sea ports / ships / vessels, land ports and ICDs on the basis of authorizations issued by respective designated authority of the railways, airport, seaport, land port and ICDs.
- f) As per direction 15 (ii) of 17th April 2020 referred to at Sr. No. 6 above, industries / industrial establishments will not be allowed to operate in Mumbai Municipal limits. No worker from Hotspot / Containment Zone will be permitted to go to workplace in industries / industrial establishments, permitted outside Mumbai.

- g) In consonance with directions of 17th April 2020, referred to above at Sr. No. 6, at paragraph No. 16 (i) regarding construction activities of public projects, construction, resurfacing, repairs, pot hole filling of roads and bridges, works of laying and repairs of water supply, sewer and stormwater drain lines, construction repairs and pre-monsoon desilting of storm water drains networks, construction of health infrastructure facilities will be allowed to operate subject to observance of COVID-19 safety guidelines.
- h) In consonance with directions of 17th April 2020, referred to above at Sr. No. 6, at paragraph No. 16 (iii) regarding construction activities of private projects, if construction workers are available at site and no workers are required to be brought from outside (in situ construction) and if the construction project incharge undertakes in writing to observe all COVID-19 safety related Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs), on satisfaction with the request and undertaking, respective Ch.E.(D.P.) may permit the construction activity on projects approved by him.
- i) All MCGM staff of the pay scale equivalent to Executive Engineer and above shall remain present in their office. Attendance of all other staff below the rank of Executive Engineer, shall not be less than 10%. 100% staff engaged in emergency duties shall attend their respective workplace.

 Jt. M.C. (G.A.) shall issue guidelines in this regard.
