
COVID19 Media Bulletin - Dated-12/08/2020

Assam has been at the forefront of this fight against Covid19 since the first patient was detected on 31st March 2020. The state has so far successfully combated this disease by following all health protocols & guidelines issued by WHO & MoHFW. The State is still relentlessly fighting the pandemic with the support of its health department in convergence with other departments. In India so far total 23,29,638 confirmed cases with 46,091 deaths have been reported.


In this context, Assam state has strengthened the surveillance and control measures against the outbreak of this disease.

• Covid19 Counseling Centers (CCC) in Guwahati: To combat the rising curve of Covi19 cases in Guwahati the Govt of the Assam has set up 31 Covid19 Counseling Centers (CCC) has been set up in each and every ward under Guwahati Municipal Corporation. These centers will act as screening and testing centers for Covid19. All citizens of Guwahati are requested to use these facilities and come forward for voluntary testing. These CCC's will provide the following services-

In continuation of our efforts to combat the rising curve in Kamrup Metro District, the Government of Assam has
taken a unique initiate to set up Covid Counseling Centers in 60 Area Sabha Wise. The Covid Counselling Centers
will provide the following services: Covid Counseling, Swab Collection, Medical Examination, Result Reporting,
Shifting of Positive cases to isolation centers, disseminating information regarding Covid.

• Covid19 Assam Highlights:

- A revised SOP has been issued with regard to air travelers visiting Assam. Air passenger who departs from Assam within 72 hours of arrival need not undergo quarantine subject to some conditions as per the revised SOP.
- Flight and train passengers will be tested through Antigen kits at the airport and railway station itself; if found positive they shall be directly taken to CCCs or COVID hospitals, in case the report is negative they can go for home quarantine for after which they will go through RTPCR test.
- A person can donate 400 gm of plasma within 3 months duration of his recovery from COVID-19. It is an appeal to all the recovered COVID-19 patients within the state to come forward after their recovery and donate their plasma after all due medical procedures.
