

THE VOICE OF CHARITIES FACING COVID-19 WORLDWIDE

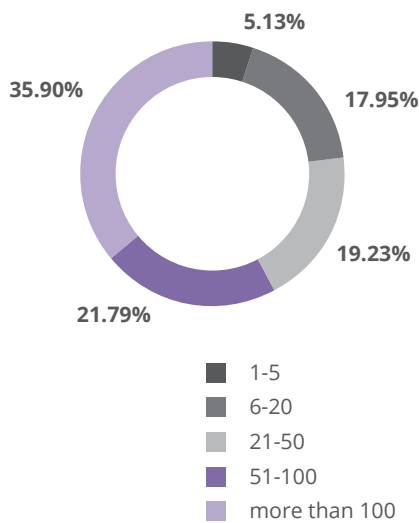
COUNTRY SNAPSHOT | INDIA

From April 30 to May 6, in its second COVID-19 survey, CAF America polled 880 organizations representing 122 countries to learn how the coronavirus pandemic continues to impact their work. 78 organizations working in India responded to the survey. 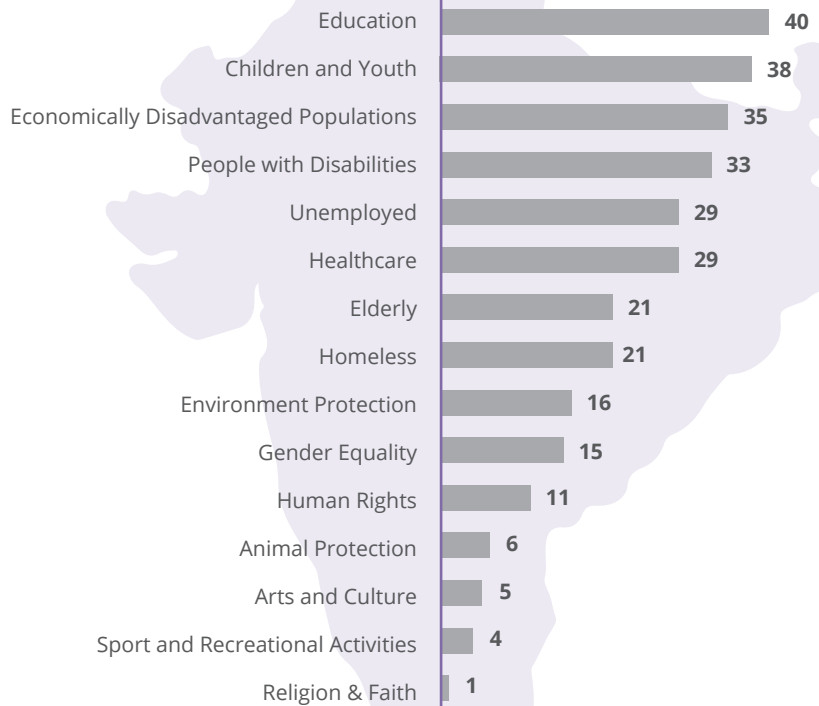

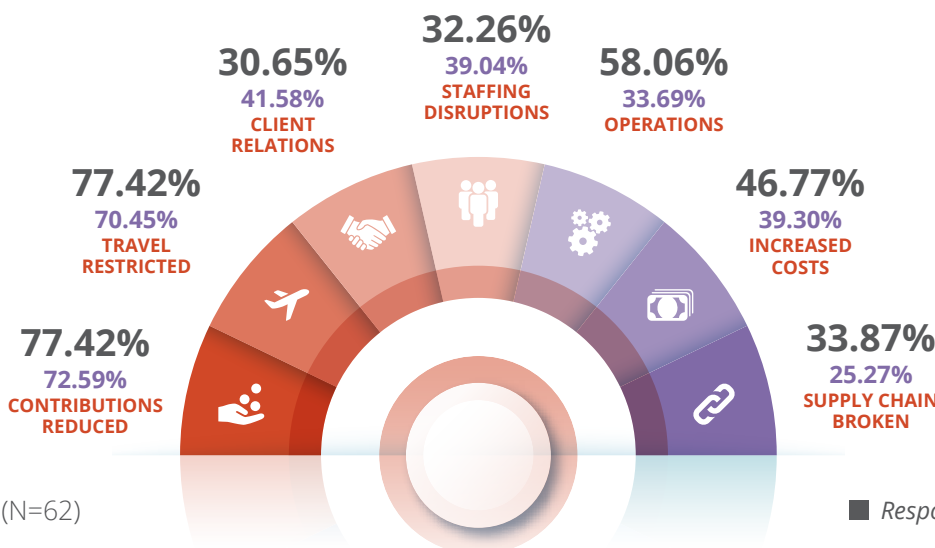

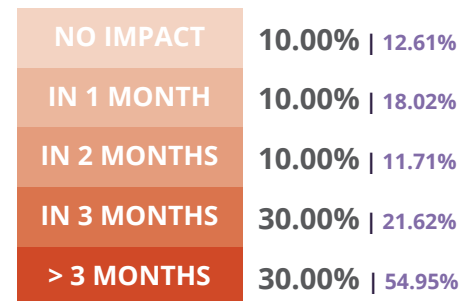


IMPACT

The majority, 92.42% of the responding organizations in India, reported being **negatively impacted** by the coronavirus global pandemic. Close to 80% of the respondents have seen a **significant reduction in the contributions** they receive and had to suspend travel and events. (N=66)



Only 10% of the responding organizations do not expect to be negatively impacted within the next 12 months. (N=10)

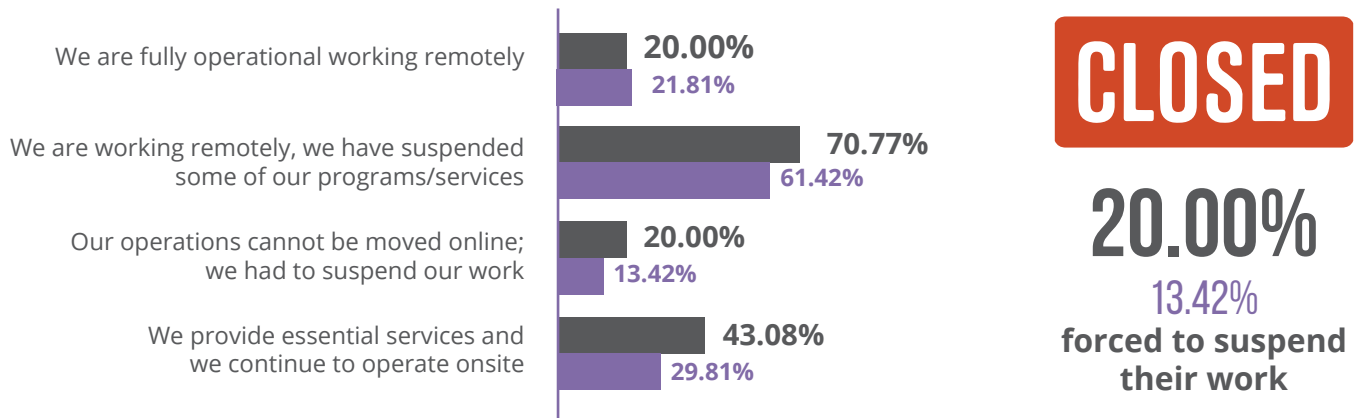

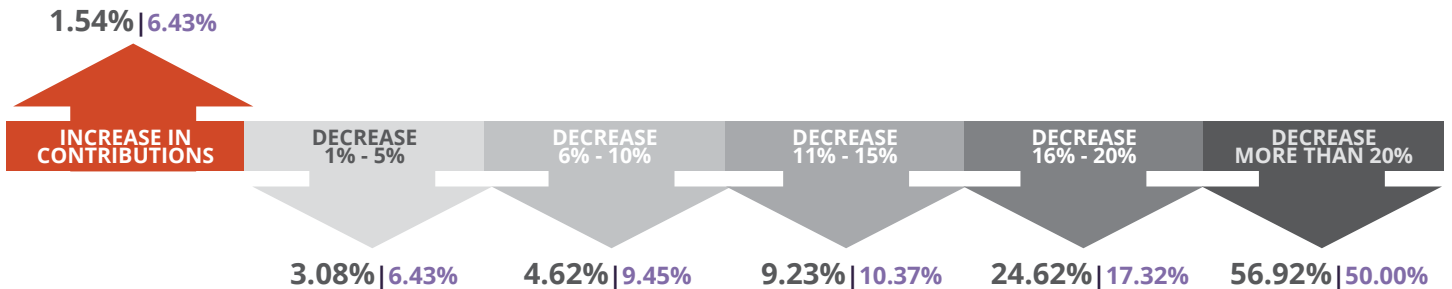
OPERATIONS

20% of the organizations surveyed in India were forced to suspend their operations. More than 70% have reported that they had to eliminate or suspend some of their regular programs and services. (N=65)

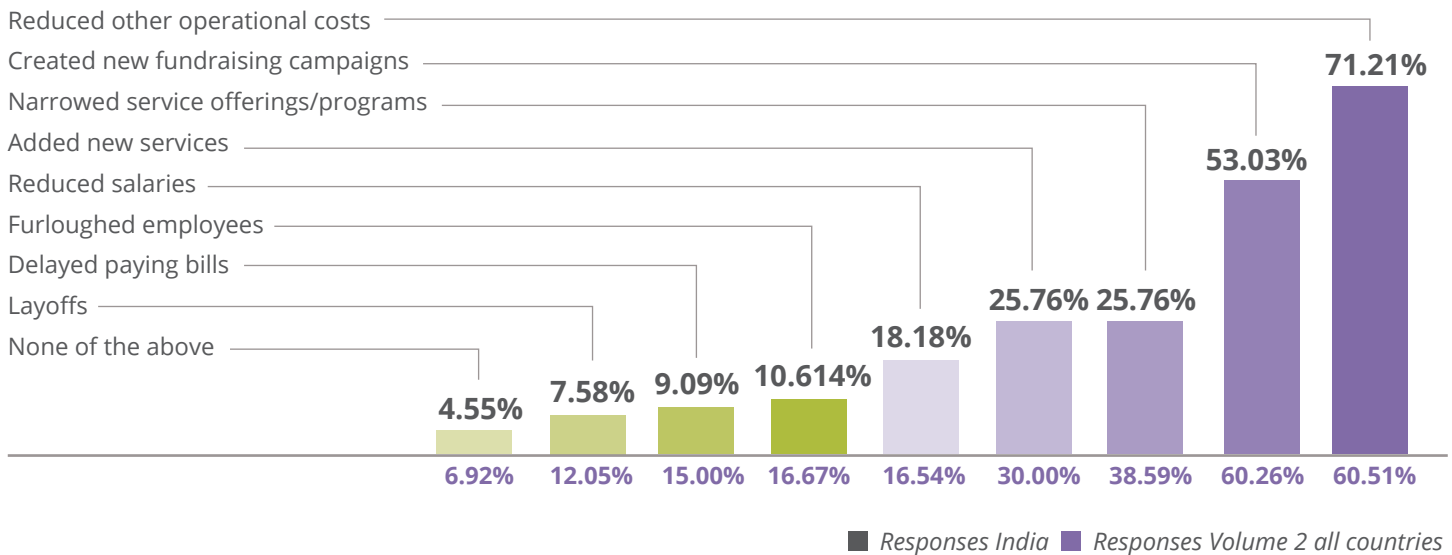


FINANCIAL SECURITY AND SUSTAINABILITY

What impact on contributions (revenues) do you expect the coronavirus global pandemic to have on your operations in the next 12 months? (N=65)

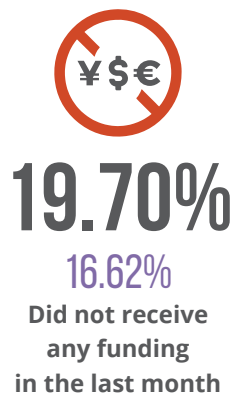
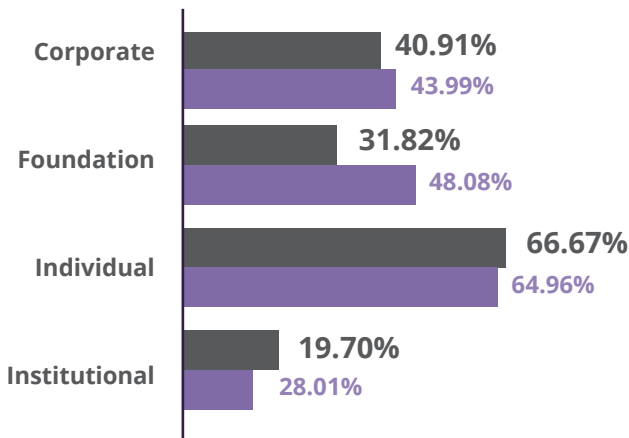


What measures have you taken to manage/deal with the impact of the pandemic on your organization? (N=66)

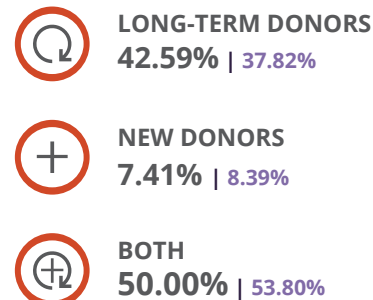

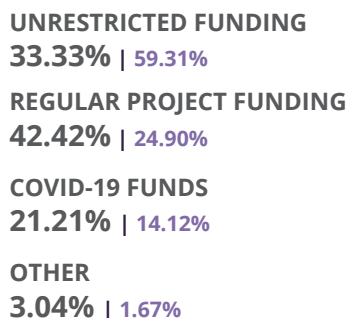
Did your organization receive funding from any of the following sources in the last month? (N=66)

What type of funding do you need the most? (N=66)



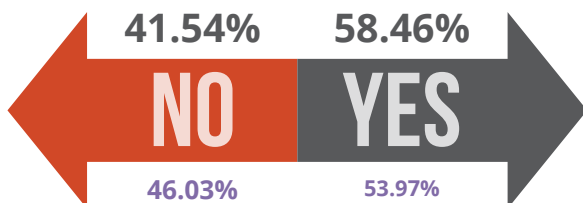

We cannot restrict our support only to those affected directly by COVID-19. The need for our services continues to rise and it's a big challenge to cover staff salaries.

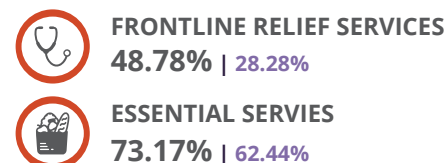
CORONAVIRUS RESPONSE

KEYS TO SUCCESS

When asked about the key to successfully continuing their operations, the responding organizations from India highlighted the following three determining factors: access to continued funding, their team's commitment and creativity, and access to technology. Understanding the emergency of the pandemic and prioritizing beneficiary needs were also key to successfully continuing operations for a number of respondents. (N=58)
